Daily Weather Forecast Distribution

Saturday 25 July 2026

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General Situation

The monsoon trough lie across the upper North and the upper Northeast while the moderate southwest monsoon prevails over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf with isolated heavy rains are forecast in Thailand and isolated very heavy rains are possible in the East. People should beware of heavy to very heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash floods, overflows and landslides especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands.

The moderate wind and waves in the upper Andaman Sea are about 2 meters high, in the lower Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf, the wave 1 - 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers.

In addition, severe tropical storm “NOUL” over the upper South China Sea, It is forecast to make landfall over Guangdong, China On 26 July 2026. This storm is forecast to not move to Thailand. The travelers should check the weather forecast for the region you're going to be visiting.

Weather Forecast for Thailand from Saturday Noon to Sunday Noon

<u>North</u>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Mae Hong Son, Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Phayao, Nan, Lampang, Tak, Phitsanulok and Phetchabun. Minimum temperature 22-26 °C. Maximum temperature 31-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
<u>Northeast</u>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Loei, Nong Khai, Bueng Kan, Udon Thani, Sakon Nakhon, Nakhon Phanom, Kalasin, Mukdahan, Amnat Charoen, Ubon Ratchathani and Nakhon Ratchasima. Minimum temperature 23-25 °C. Maximum temperature 32-36 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
<u>Central</u>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Kanchanaburi, Lopburi and Saraburi. Minimum temperature 24-26 °C. Maximum temperature 35-37 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
<u>East</u>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy heavy rain in Nakhon Nayok, Prachin Buri, Sa Kaeo, Rayong, Chanthaburi and Trat. Minimum temperature 23-26 °C. Maximum temperature 32-37 °C. Southwesterly winds 15-35 km./hr. Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<u>South, east coast</u>	Scatered thundershowers mostly in Chumphon, Surat Thani, Nakhon Si Thammarat, Songkhla, Yala and Narathiwat. Minimum temperature 24-26 °C. Maximum temperature 32-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 15-35 km./hr. Wave height about 1 meter, 1-2 meters offshore and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<u>South, west coast</u>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Ranong, Phang Nga, Phuket, Trang and Satun. Minimum temperature 23-25 °C. Maximum temperature 29-32 °C. From Phang Nga northward: Southwesterly winds 20-35 km./hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. From Phuket southward: Southwesterly winds 15-35 km./hr. Wave height 1 - 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<u>Bangkok and vicinity</u>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain Minimum temperature 27-28 °C. Maximum temperature 36-37 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.

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
